2. Its name means “greater” from the asterism of its main seven stars,.

3. This constellation predates the Greeks located in the southern sky with symbol 

4. This charioteer is in the northern sky

5. This bright belt is best seen during winter

6. This water carrier contains two planetary nebulae

7. This centaur with drawn bow is in the southern sky

8. This ‘maiden’ constellation contains the Sombrero Galaxy

9. Constellation in northern sky named after a vain Greek Queen

10. Mythology says Zeus transformed this constellation to abduct Europa

11. Named after a mythical princess sacrificed to a sea monster

12. Represents the King married to Cassiopeia
