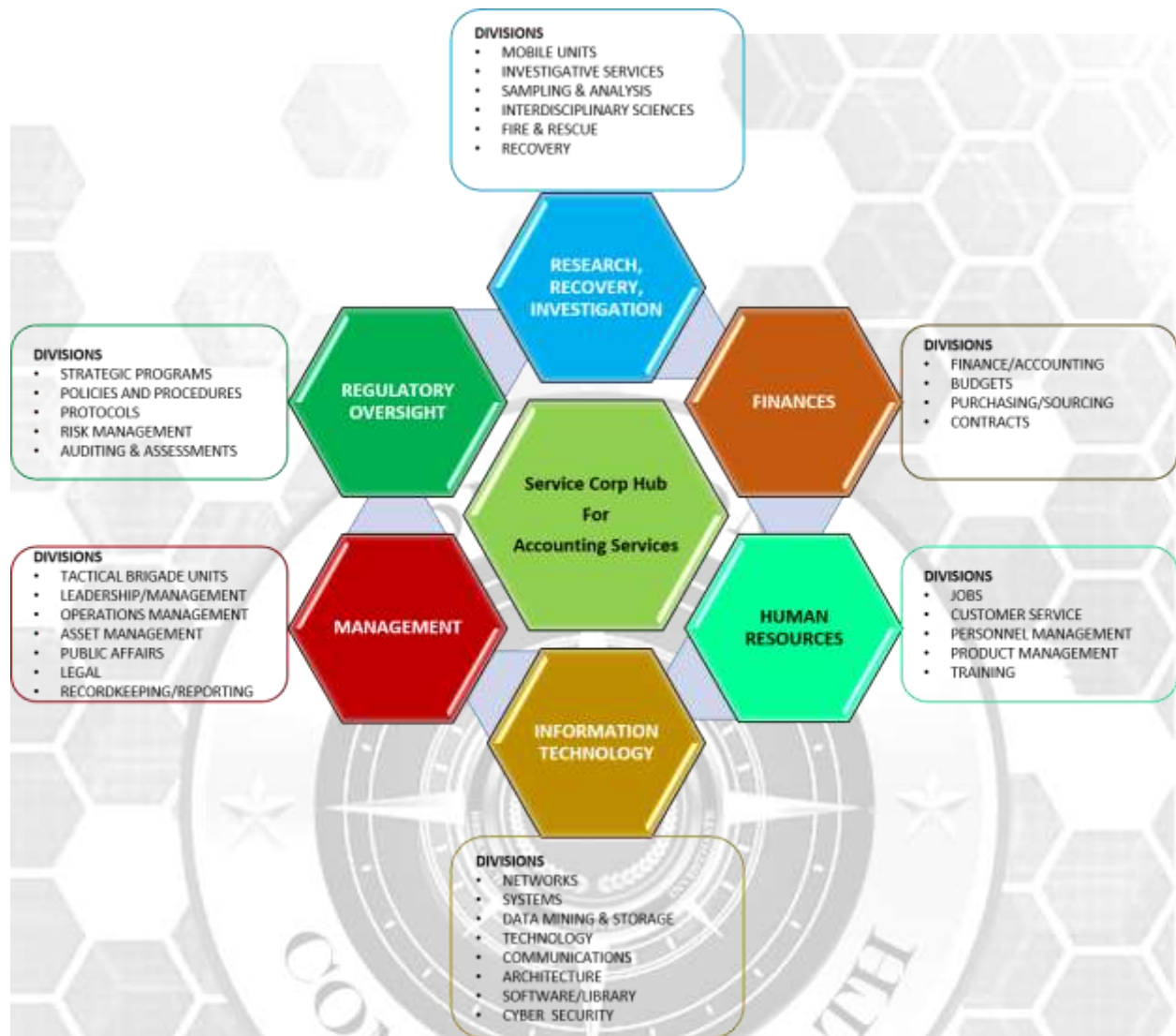
**ASTROCONVERGENCE DISCIPLINE:** Addressing challenges, barriers, and unknown subject matter will not be solved by one discipline alone. It will require the integration of knowledge, methods and expertise from across Astroconvergence to solve troublesome problems, especially those focusing on societal needs. It has three primary characteristics:

- It will be driven by specific and compelling problems, whether problems arise from questions or pressing societal needs.
- It will provide deep integration across disciplines. Astroconvergence intentionally brings together intellectually diverse experts and researchers to develop effective ways of communicating across disciplines. As experts from different disciplines pursue the challenges, barriers, and unknown subject matter, their knowledge, theories, methods, data and communities increasingly intermingle.
- New frameworks, paradigms or even disciplines will emerge from astroconvergence, as Service Corps adopt common frameworks, new knowledge, and a new language. In this sense, astroconvergence is the pinnacle of Exopolitics integration across disciplines.

DISCIPLINE	SCOPE
ACCULTURATION	The process of acculturation refers to the socialization process by which individuals blend the values, customs, norms, cultural attitudes, and behaviors of the overarching host culture. Acculturation is a process in which an individual adopts, acquires and adjusts to a new cultural environment as a result of separation, integration, assimilating, and marginalizing into a new culture. Acculturation can result in changes to culture, religious practices, health care, and other social institutions, as well as, significant ramifications to the food, clothing, and language of those becoming introduced to the overarching culture. This process can cause changes in daily behavior, as well as numerous changes in psychological and physical well-being.

<p><b>ACQUIRED RESOURCES AND TECHNOLOGY</b></p>	<p>The Exopolitics Acquired Resources and Technology Platforms are commonly understood as a wide range of tangible and intangible assets that are acquired from Extraterrestrial sources that are documented, planned, procured, secured, evaluated, trained, and assigned across Service Corps. Categories may include: financial resources; physical resources such as premises, technology, and equipment; knowledge resources (Extraterrestrial resources; structural resources; and relational resources); human resources including both the physical staff, but also the individuals background and experiences; and social resources that include the personal, professional networks, and reputational resources.</p>
<p><b>ADVOCACY</b></p>	<p>The Exopolitics Advocacy Program provides processes and procedures for active support of an ideas or causes expressed through strategies and methods that influence the opinions and decisions of people, Service Corps, and communities. The aims of advocacy are to create or change policies, laws, regulations, distribution of resources or other decisions that affect lives and to ensure that such decisions lead to implementation and success.</p>
<p><b>BIODIVERSITY OF RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT</b></p>	<p>The Biodiversity of Research and Development Platforms offers applications, research, procedures and processes to discover organic biodiversity, genetic variations, afford protections, identify obstacles, seek out new opportunities, and provide life-cycle conservation, preservation, and actions across Service Corps, to humans and Extraterrestrial visitors, and communities of Omicron Commonwealth.</p>
<p><b>EDUCATION</b></p>	<p>The Education Discipline is a purposeful activity of receiving, or giving systematic instruction, and the continual improvement of achieving specific aims, such as acquiring, comprehending, and transmitting knowledge, acquiring and fostering skills, encompassing new ideas, and developing character traits. This includes the development of understanding, rationality, critical thinking, integrity, and technological applications.</p>
<p><b>POLICY</b></p>	<p>The Policy Discipline is the purposeful activity, support of, and continual improvement of: laws, regulations, procedures, administrative actions, incentives, or voluntary practices of Omicron Commonwealth, communities, and the Service Corps.</p>
